 - White UA zip up jacket REQUIRED... Optional: white sweatshirt(s)
 - To School on Friday: New team shirt & new white sweatpants & white UA zip up jacket (girls: hair comp ready... boys you too! Ha ha)
 - Pack Complete GRAY Uniform (Gray Top, Gray Skirt, red Bloomers, white no show socks, CLEAN cheer shoes (2 pairs for flyers), Red COMP hair bow, RED UA mask, gray or skin color sports bra)
 - Make-up (eye lashes and lipstick!)
 - Personal Items
 - Water bottle

- Spectators: Only 2 spectators per cheerleader are allowed in the venue. Tickets must be purchased in advance on the website. - In the coaches meeting, they said they will be opening the venue approx. 1 hour before our session starts at 3pm (that's an approximate, due to the sanitization being done between the sessions). ALSO: Please note that the Covid Spectator capacity of the RP Funding Center is approx. 1500 (normally 8,100). The best advice I can give you is get there early!
- Seating FYI: It will be first come first serve and due to Covid guidelines, there is NO priority seating (priority seating is when parents/fans can come down to the competition floor level and watch your team when they perform). My suggestion is to arrive early and try to get seats together so that your athletes can see you (and hear you) from the stands. Athletes will be sitting in a SEPARATE venue than spectators this year. Parents will be in the arena and athletes in the Theatre. Athletes will be able to watch the competition live in the theatre.
- The RP Funding Center has safety standards in place that include Temperature checks and Masks required the entire time you are in the venue.
- Parking is \$10/vehicle (cash only)
